## Supplementary Regulations

### [1] Announcement

Yorkshire Land Rover Owners Club will hold an open RTV, Clubmans Off-Road Trial on 15 September 2018 at Sour Leys Farm, Helmsley, YO62 5LD

### [2] Jurisdiction

This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), the ALRC Competition Regulation as published in the current handbook and the following supplementary regulations of the YLROC.

### [3] Permits

MSA Permit No(s): 108442

### [4] Eligibility

- I. Drivers
  - I.1. All drivers must have a valid, full RTA licence
  - I.2. A competitive club membership card signed with the MSA endorsement.
  - I.3. The maximum number of entries will be 36, minimum will be 16.
  - I.4. Fully elected members of the Association of Land Rover Clubs, Pennine LRC, NORC, Peak & Dukeries ORC, BADLRC, NCORTC, YORC.
  - I.5. Entries will be on a first come, first served basis. The organisers, without giving a reason, may refuse entry.
- II. Vehicles
  - II.1. All vehicles must comply with the current vehicle and technical regulations of the MSA Competitors Year Book
  - II.2. P56.1
  - II.3. P56.2
  - II.4. P56.11
  - II.5. P60.2.2 Towing points need not be painted in contrasting colour.
  - II.6. J5.20.6 Vehicles of a commercial type such as a van or pickup intended solely for commercial or goods carrying are allowed.
  - II.7. J5.21.1
  - II.8. J5.21.5 Fixed or Hand Held Video Cameras carried on board a vehicle are subject to written approval of the Chief Scrutineer.
  - II.9. Any ALRC recognised class of Land Rover as defined in the ALRC handbook.
  - II.10. Non-ALRC compliant motors
    - II.11. Jeeps, Austin Gipsies etc are eligible to compete.
    - II.12. Doortops are not required to be present.
    - II.13. Hoodsticks and windscreens required to be present.

II.14.No person shall travel/ ride otherwise than in a proper seat.

II.15.Tyres –V tread tractor or dumper style tyres, open block tread or very aggressive tread pattern tyres such as the Maxi-Cross, Canonica and Babcross types will not be permitted.

### **[5] Championships**

Results from this meeting may be used to correlate league tables for annual club trophies. To qualify for championship of an ALRC club, the competitor's motor must be compliant with ALRC regulations.

### **[6] Scrutineering & Event Programme**

Entries open 1<sup>st</sup> June 2018

Entries close 15<sup>th</sup> September 2018

Scrutineering open from 09:00 on 15 September 2018 at Cherry Tree Park, Station Road, Nawton, YO62 7RZ.

The event will commence at 08:30 at the advertised site location, as per the scrutineering instructions. Any competitors not signed on by 10:30 may be excluded from taking part.

### **[7] Description of Event**

The event is an off road driver/vehicle capability competition comprising of not more than twelve sections. Each section to be on a ground of approximately 1 to 2 acres (available ground permitting). Each section will contain twelve markers with points being awarded for striking the marker canes.

The following vehicle classes will apply; -

- Class 1 – leaf sprung vehicles up to 84”
- Class 2 – leaf sprung vehicles 84” – 90”
- Class 3 – leaf sprung vehicles over 90”
- Class 6 – modified leaf sprung vehicles up to 84”
- Class 7 – modified sprung vehicles 84” – 90”
- Class 8 – modified leaf sprung vehicles over 90”

### **[8] Vehicle Start Positions**

The Clerk of Course or designated marshal will decide the running order which will be announced at the driver's briefing.

### **[9] Practising**

No practising will be allowed. Vehicles may be allowed on the competition area for testing, at the C of C's consent.

### **[10] Judges of Fact**

- I. Multiple entries of a vehicle will be permitted.
- II. Maximum speed limit off section in all areas is 5 mph – failure to comply may result in exclusion.

- III. Points are awarded for striking canes or numbers, stopping within the section, or leaving the boundary of the section. Points to be awarded by the marshal on the section. Any disputes should be brought to the immediate attention of the scoring marshal, and if not resolved, the C of C.
- IV. Prizes are awarded as per section 12 of the supplementary regulations.
- V. A driver may have only one navigator at a time, but up to navigators may sign on and ride with that driver only.
- VI. A driver commencing the event with a navigator must carry a navigator through each section. At the discretion of the C of C, a sole navigator may not attempt all the sections, without penalty.
- VII. In the event of a breakdown, a driver may complete the event in another driver's vehicle in the same class.

**[11] Registration and Fees**

Registration is on the day of the event or by prior completion of the published booking form. If registering by booking form, this is to be sent to the address below by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018.

The fee is set at £20.00 per vehicle.

The organisers have the right to amalgamate classes if necessary.
